Who's behind it Arthur Potts Dawson, who leads the kitchen at the fashionably green Acorn House, in Kings Cross. Potts Dawson has been the head chef of the River Café and Fifteen, and trained under the Roux brothers. This Hoxton venture is his second, with recycling of most items in the restaurant, and veg-growing on-site.

What's on the menu Properly seasonal, winter fare: smoked mackerel with celeriac and apple remoulade (£8.50), followed by slow-roast lamb shoulder with gratin dauphinoise and mint for main course (£16).

And to drink Many decent Italian bottles to choose from: 2005 Fontodi Chianti Classico (£35) and 2006 Soave Classico made by Pierpoan (£27).
